1. File Types

The content in this Asset Bank may come in different and multiple file formats. The three main file types are PNGs, JPEGs, and PDFs, and they are used in different ways. It's important to make sure you download the correct version.

- a. **PNG:** these are usually a smaller size file and are suitable for online media only e.g., social media platforms, websites
- b. **JPEG:** these can vary in size and are suitable for online media and for printed materials, (some websites and social media platforms have a limit on the resolution, high resolution images are better for printing)
- **c. PDFs:** these files retain the quality of images and are generally for printing or sharing.
- **d. Gaeilge:** several the resources are available as Gaeilge.


| Folder | Contents | Uses |

| Educators | Collection of resources for educators on wildlife of the Iveragh peninsula. | These resources can be used in the indoor or outdoor classroom, with small, large groups of children. They contain information about species, habitats, and activity sheets that you can photocopy and share. |
| Images | Collection of images from the Iveragh peninsula that include people, activities, towns, places, wildlife, and landscapes. | These high-resolution images can be downloaded and used online on social media platforms, websites or in printed marketing materials publications. |
| Information & Guides | A selection of informative guides to sustainable tourism activities on the Iveragh peninsula. | There are multiple copies of the resources in this file, suitable for social media and websites (pngs, jpegs) and print quality (pdfs). |
| Maps | Collection of illustrated maps | These illustrative maps can be used online and in printed materials. Make sure to download the right file so it is fit for purpose. |
| Publications | Collection of reports and publications about the Iveragh peninsula | A collection of reports and publications relating to different aspects, research and activities carried out on the Iveragh peninsula. |





3. How to use this Google Drive Asset Bank

General Overview of Google Drive



- These are the folders containing the resources. When you first open Google
 Drive these may be in folders or in a list like the image above. It varies depending
 on what browser and operating system you use (E.g., Chrome, Safari, Mac, PC).

 You can toggle this on your screen, depending on your preference.
- 2. You can search for file types, e.g., PDF, Photos, and Images.
- You can search by location, name, or activity e.g., Ballinskelligs, butterfly, surfing.







Toggle/Change View

Grid Layout









How to open a folder:

1. Double click or tap on a folder to open it.

- 2. Click or tap on the download button




How to open a file in a folder:






1. The same as opening a folder, you can double click or tap on a file to open it.



How to download a file in a folder:

1. You can directly download a file the same way you download a folder (right click to bring up menu, and click download)

If you have an image open and you want to download it follow these steps:

- 1. To open and image, click or tap on it.
- 2. In the right corner you will see three dots , click or tap on these to bring up the options menu
- 3. Click or tap on the download button.
